Overview


- Founded in 2010 in response to the Haiti Earthquake by two Marines.

- Individual homeowners
- Vulnerable and at-risk populations
- Rural and urban populations lacking proper insurance and resources
- Exception: Veterans and First Responders
- All services provided at no cost to the homeowner.
- Cost basis tracked for all services provided and data given back to community leaders for their use with FEMA, etc.

Operation Golden Grizzly

April 19 – May 21, 2024

Team Rubicon will have approximately 70 volunteers per day, working 7 days a week, serving El Dorado County communities.

Scope of the Operation:

- Hazardous tree removal
- Fuel reduction
- Creating Defensible Space



Capabilities we bring

- Wildfire Mitigation, Recovery and Defensible Space
 - Saw teams capable of cutting down hazardous trees
 - Bucking and limbing downed trees
 - Perform Defensible Space work in accordance with CalFire recommendations.
 - Ingress/Egress route clearance
- Defensible Space Assessments
 - NFPA-trained volunteers capable of performing Home Ignition Zone/Defensible Space assessments.



Focus on EDC Communities

- EDC Resource Conservation District (RCD) has provided Team Rubicon with 90+ locations for hazardous tree removal.
- Grizzly Flats Firesafe Council is gathering ROEs for residents needing assistance with managing defensible space.
- Beyond Operation Golden Grizzly, Team Rubicon will continue to support EDC and surrounding
 Counties.
